NEW REGISTRATION LOCATION FOR 2011

Hospitality House registration, free parking and free shuttle service is located at **The Mall at Tuttle Crossing- Macy's at Hayden Run**. Registration and shuttle service begins at 8:30 a.m.

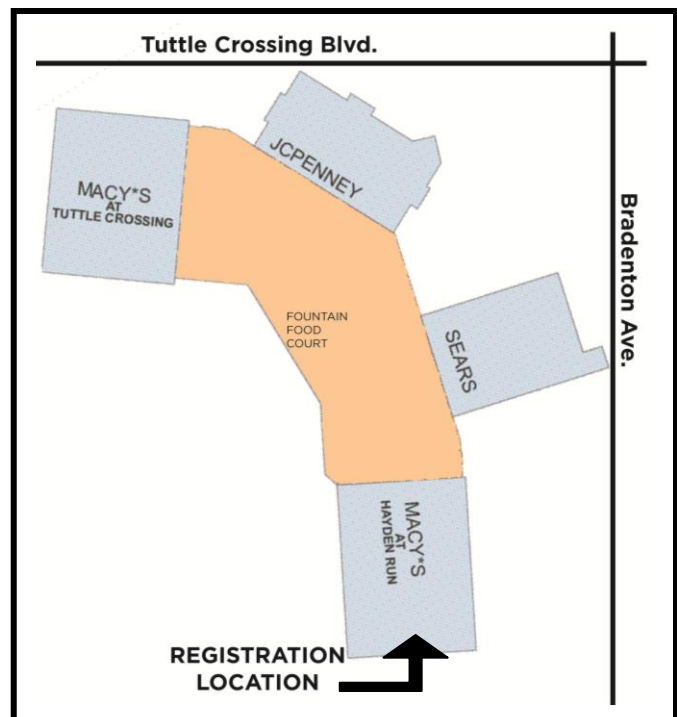
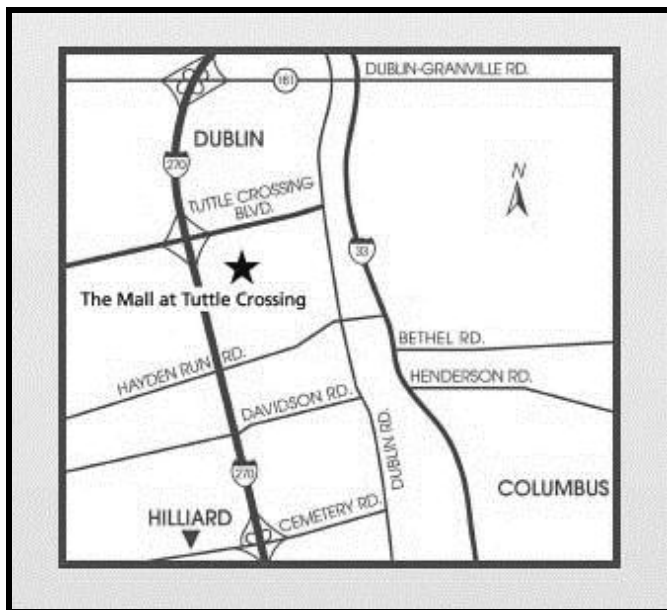

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE MALL AT TUTTLE CROSSING- MACY'S AT HAYDEN RUN

Exit I-270 at the Tuttle Crossing ramp. Go east on Tuttle Crossing Blvd. Turn right onto Bradenton Ave. (next to the Marathon gas station). At the stop sign, turn left onto Blazer Parkway. Proceed around the road (past Sears). Turn right into the Macy's at Hayden Run parking lot on the first level. **Park in lot B30.**

NOTE: there are two Macy's at The Mall at Tuttle Crossing. Registration is at the Macy's at Hayden Run located between Sears and the Fountain Food Court.



HOSPITALITY HOUSE SCHEDULE

The Experience Columbus Hospitality House is open **Thursday, June 2- Sunday, June 5, 2011**.
Here is the schedule you can expect during your day of VIP treatment:

- 8:30 a.m. Registration area opens and shuttle service begins to the Hospitality House.
Hot breakfast is served until 10 a.m.
Continental breakfast is available until 10:30 a.m.
- 11:30 a.m. Bar opens, lunch is available from the grill until 3 p.m.
- 6:30 p.m. Bar closes.
- 7 p.m. **Final** shuttle back to the registration location leaves the Hospitality House.
Rain or shine, the last shuttle is at 7 p.m.

EXPERIENCE COLUMBUS HOSPITALITY HOUSE GUIDELINES

The Hospitality House is located off the third fairway; there is a private gate cut for access to/from the course for those with PGA tickets and a hospitality pass.

Spikes and cleats are prohibited.

Cell phones are permitted at the Hospitality House. However, cell phones are prohibited on the golf course.

The Hospitality House does not have public phones. Public phones are available on the golf course in designated areas.

There is no storage location at the Hospitality House for personal items.

Hospitality passes are required for guests seven years and older.

THE MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT SECURITY GUIDELINES

PGA badges are to be displayed in plain sight at all times. The Memorial Tournament is not responsible for lost badges.

No food or beverage is permitted on the golf course. No beverage containers of any type are to be taken on or off the golf course, including water bottles.

Still cameras are permitted Monday- Wednesday of the tournament week. Still cameras are prohibited Thursday- Sunday. Video equipment is prohibited during the entire tournament week.

For safety of the players and gallery members alike, a no autograph policy will be enforced on the golf course during the week of the Memorial Tournament, including practice rounds. In consideration of the players, spectators are asked to refrain from requesting autographs during competition and must wait until a player has completed his round.

The following items are prohibited on the course all week:

Backpacks/large purses	Ladders	Signs
Beepers	Periscopes	TVs
Camera/binocular cases	Pets/animals	Video camera
Cellular phones	Picnic baskets	Weapons
Coolers	Radios	
Folding armchairs	Segways	

Prohibited items of any kind cannot be left at security checkpoints. You will be required to return them to your vehicle.

Strollers are permitted on the course.

Access to Memorial Drive between Muirfield Drive and Dublin Road will be restricted to vehicles with proper credentials.
